### **Background:**

The winter freeze-thaw cycles can create significant grade variations on pedestrian walkways creating dangerous trip hazards and liability exposure for the Municipality. There are three sources of funding opportunities for sidewalk replacement:

- 1. Lifecycle used to replace long sections of damaged sidewalks
- 2. Capital used to install new sidewalks
- 3. Operating used to replace various panels (small sections) that need to be replaced due to failed Minimum Maintenance requirements.

In the last 3 years, the Public Works operating budget for sidewalk replacement in Chatham has been significantly underfunded at \$91,121. This budget request is to address the gap in funding in order to complete the necessary maintenance.
