## **Background:**

This item is a major system upgrade to GIS software and infrastructure, with a focus on cloud and mobile technologies, data and application collaboration with internal and external partners, and the ability to integrate with other business applications and workflows. This upgrade will implement technology to support open data applications for transparent government and innovation.

In 2020, Chatham-Kent completed an extensive "GIS System Architecture Review and Design", to provide direction and best practices for implementing this new technology.
